



TEACHER EDUCATION GRANT

This is a pilot program to help with registration costs for educational workshops for middle school and high school teachers in Broomfield public schools.

Middle School and High School classroom teachers may apply for a grant to help pay registration fees for education workshops that will enhance classroom teaching and is approved by their school principal. Teachers in five public schools in the Broomfield community are eligible to apply. These include Broomfield High School, Legacy High School, Broomfield Heights Middle School, Aspen Creek Grades 6-8, and Westlake Middle School. Each school will be limited to a maximum of \$1000 per school year in grants and the individual request is limited to \$200.

It's easy to apply. Complete the form below and fax or mail it along with a copy of the course brochure and registration form. Application must be signed by the applicant and the school principal. A brief summary report must be submitted to the Foundation upon completion of the workshop.
